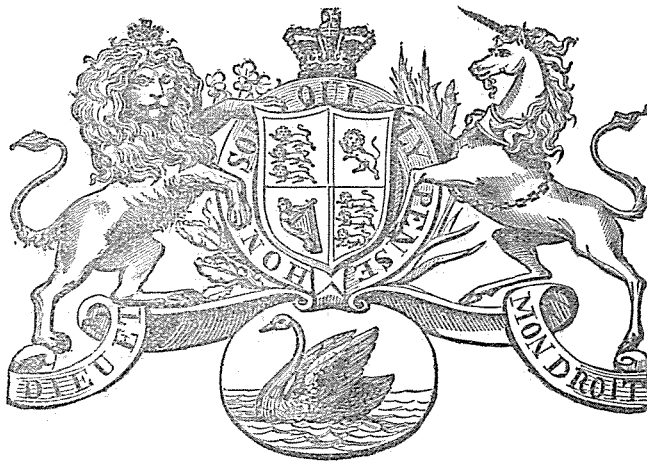

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,

THAT on or about the 15th March next, and thereafter during the time of building the Light House on the "Great Basses" Rocks off the S. E. Coast of Ceylon, a Light Vessel will be placed in 12 Fathoms Water about One Mile N. N. E. of the Rocks;—and in order to distinguish her from the Light Vessel at the "Little Basses" which exhibits a White Flash every $1\frac{1}{2}$ Minute, and which is 20 Miles distant, the Light shewn will be *Red revolving* at intervals of 45 Seconds.

By day she will be distinguished by carrying two Balls Vertically at the Main Mast Head.
