WILLIAM10 BOXSHALL (THOMAS9, THOMAS8, WILLIAM7, JOHN6 BOXALL, JOHN5, HENRY4, RICHARD3, RICHARD2, RICHARD1) was born 1832 in Eashing, Surrey, England, and died 15 Jan 1893 in Berkshire Valley, Western Australia (Source: Died of Cancer of the Liver.). He married MARY ANN KELLY 04 May 1863 in St Mary Perth, Western Australia, daughter of THOMAS KELLY and CATHERINE FARRELL. She was born 02 Mar 1847 in Umballa, India, and died 03 Feb 1887 in Berkshire Valley, Western Australia.

Notes for WILLIAM BOXSHALL:

William was transported to Western Australia for stealing 60.00 pounds from a shop & burning paper. he received 7 years & arrived in Fremantle aboard the William Hammond in 1864

Medical Notes: Height 5'8", Hair Light Brown, Eyes Grey, Face Shape Round, Complexion Fresh, Build Middling Stout, Scar right arm, Tatoo Crown & Anchor left arm

Criminal Conviction: Robbery Shop breaking & Larceny, 20 Oct 1852, Preston Lancashire England. Was that he stole, at Fulwood on 23 August 1852, three 5 pound notes, one ten pound note, 24 sovereigns & 12 pounds in silver from George Worthington. He was aged 21 & his accomplice was John Jones aged 19. Both were in the 50th Regiment

William BOXALL of Fulwood together with John Jones, a labourer from the same town were charged at the Preston Quarter Sessions on the 20th October 1852 that they did:  
"At Fulwood in the shop of Arthur Phipps RUDMAN there situate feloniously did break & enter & leight pieces of paper to the value of 1 penny of the property of Arthur Phipps RUDMAN & sixty one pounds in money, the monies the property of the siad Arthur Phipps RUDMAN in the said shop, then & there found & being then & there in the said shop by force & arms feloniously did steal take & carry away against the form of the statute in such case made & provided & against the peace of our said Lady the Queen & her Crown & dignity & jurors afore-said upon their oath aforesaid do further present that the said William BOXALL & John JONES afterward to wit on the same day & year aforesaid at Fulwood aforesaid in the county aforesaid the shop of one George WORTHINGTON there feloniously did break & enter & light pieces of paper & sixty one pounds in money of the property of the said George WORTHINGTON in the said shop then & there being found then & there in the said shop by force of Arms fe!  
loniously did steal & take & carry away against the form of the statute in such case made & provided, & against the peace of our Lady the Queen her Crown & Dignity.  
William BOXALL pleaded guilty to the charge as read & John JONES was tried & found guilty. Borth recieved a sentance of transportation for ten years
